We use a range of wonderful materials, including Jolly Phonics, Fitzroy Readers and Seeing Stars programmes.

As well as British English intonation and spelling, the children have the opportunity to hear Australian, American and Canadian accents. We use books from various sources and the children learn to adapt to various spelling as well.

All music used at Kspace is produced and performed by our own teachers. Children love to play a part in the performance and enjoy watching themselves and their teammates at home too.

Shooting Star Themes

Shining Stars follow exciting monthlythemes. Each theme covers interesting new subjects, concepts and easy-to-use language. We teach the songs, words, greetings and mini-phrases that children of this age commonly use.

Saturday School Meals


Children can order a special snack & meal set that is catered for them by Kspace, or you may send in packed lunch.
