

Allergy & Safety Note

If your child has any allergies please ensure that you let us know at enrollment stage. If your child develops an allergy or one is discovered after enrolment, please advise Kspace immediately. ALL PARENTS are required to closely follow our strict Prohibited Foods Policy. See below. Any food that breaks this code must unfortunately be thrown away (off premises), without exception.

Although Kspace endeavours to prevent students from coming in contact with allergic foods, Kspace cannot guarantee that students will never be exposed to such allergic foods on Kspace premises. Parents MUST understand that while we will do all we can to prevent exposure, this is not guaranteed.

Food allergy alert t-shirts are available and parents are encouraged to purchase these if your child has a food allergy. If your child has an epi-pen, please notify Kspace and present an in-date one to reception each day your child is in Kspace.

If your child develops an allergic reaction to food or other, you will be contacted immediately. If expert medical attention is deemed necessary, Kspace will notify/solicit medical services without your physical presence.

If you select lunch containing 'notified' allergen, your child will be given a different lunch, without notice.

Prohibited Foods List & Guide

Drink: Only water for the children's drinks please. Send in a full drinking bottle that is labeled with your child's name, and you can give your child an extra bottle or water (labeled) if they get very thirsty.

No milk, yoghurt drinks, fruit juice, or any type of tea or other drinks are allowed, including Japanese tea.

Note: Unfortunately we cannot wash out your child's water bottle at the end of the day.

Food: We have a very strict school policy that must never be broken please. We have children with fatal allergies at the school and we wish to protect them and keep the school hazard-free at all times.

NO: - Nuts

- Sesame
- Chocolates
- Products that contain nuts (even trace elements) or are made near nuts or in same factory. Sweets/candies
- Mochi, dango and konyaku or any jellies are all strictly banned

None of these items are allowed in the building. Also, when we have community events and picnics you will also be asked not to provide these items.

Packed Lunches: Food that is sent in packed lunches must not be highly perishable (like eggs) as we cannot store food. Please avoid strong odours e.g. natto, raw onions, kimchi etc.

Snacks: Please do not put sweets (candies/lollies) etc in your child's school bag.

Sharing: Children are not allowed to share food with anyone. They are taught not to share meals and to only eat their own food.

Food Disposal: Lunch boxes cannot be fully washed out and we do not have a policy of reporting back to parents daily how much children have eaten. If your child is observed to have any problems at all with their eating we will contact you.

Birthdays: If your child has a birthday during their visit we ask kindly that you do not send in cakes from outside or bake your own please. Children are not allowed to share or swap good at Kspace. Also, please do not provide any party bags our souvenir foods gifts to share with classmates.
