Singapore Maths A-Space Class 11th September

Learning Intention: Can I count to and back from 6 and find one less within 6?

Star words: count, less than, how many, before, back Super sentence: "one less than ____ is ____"

We had a fantastic maths class this week. The children demonstrated brilliant focus and counting skills.

The children began by practicing counting up to 10 and back from 10 using their fingers and singing songs such as 'zoom zoom'. This helped the children warm up their minds relating to the maths learning today.

The children enjoyed visiting the 'Bakers Shop' where they found 6 delicious cupcakes for sale. They had fun singing '6 cupcakes in the bakers shop' and taking it in turns to buy a cupcake and take it away. Each time a child bought a cupcake, we counted how many were left and practiced saying a super sentence such as 'one less than 5 is 4'.

The children then made their own 6 cupcakes and 'ate' one at a time. Each time counting how many were left and finding one less than.

Finally, the children practiced writing numbers to 6 by saying the number rhymes together. They stuck the correct number of cupcake pictures next to each number by careful 1:1 counting.
