Our little ones were thoroughly captivated by the end set-up and were very excited to choose their own train sets for the session. We gave them a wide variety of engines to choose from - ranging from bullet train sets, to old school steam engine trains. Playing with train sets nurtures problem solving skills, within young minds. Our young ones had to build tracks and navigate the trains along the tracks, taking care to avoid obstacles. It is a great activity to keep them engaged for hours.

It is also a highly effective way to fine tune their fine motor skills. Children also thought of different scenarios for the roles played with the train sets, creating stories in their heads relating to the trains. We handed out individual train passes (PASMO) to everyone and they were extremely delighted to play with them.

To wrap up our session, we played the road signs game, where students had to make a long chain by putting their hands on their friends shoulders to form a 'student train'. The student train then went around the Kspace town and we used road signs to teach them to stop and go, depending on what the signal displayed. Overall a successful and action-packed session!
