#### **Other Costs**

## Refunds, Make-ups and Credits

- The trial fee or Overseas Screening Fee are charged in advance and are retained in full by Kspace, even if we are unable to offer your child placement.
- Once booked and paid, we have a zero cancellation, zero refund policy (in full or part), without exception. This policy extends to cases where families might be unable to enter the country.
- Due to the short period open for Winter School 2025/26, there are no make-ups allowed for classes unattended or missed (for any reason), credits for other services, carry-overs of part charges, including for sickness absence. Fees apply to the specific dates and times that you book, and cannot be moved to different dates.
- No credits for fees paid for Winter School 2025/26 can be carried over past the winter school dates, for any reason, including for enrolled Kspace Kspace members.
- In the event of a natural disaster (earthquake/typhoon i.e. situations of force majeure) Kspace will follow recommendations by the Tokyo Metropolitan Government, however we will decide to remain open, or to close, based on Management decision. In the case of natural disaster, unfortunately we are unable to offer refund/ compensation/ make-ups etc. for attendance periods that are lost.
- The Membership Fee (for new children) and Materials Fee (for all attendees) is charged regardless of how many days booked (from 1+) and is mandatory.
- Fees must be received prior to provision of services.
- The dates of attendance and fees are paid for a specific named child.
- Positions are not secured until children's places have been verified by the School and payment has been received in full, in advance.

## Saturday, December 20th: Santa's Coming to Town!

We bring some themed movie-style drama and role-play for the children, plus big screen karaoke with special Christmas songs on the menu. All groups have age-appropriate content, with percussion, situation role-play to create memorable and rewarding experiences. They will have great fun enjoying fabulous stories 'How to Catch Santa', 'Santa's Stuck' and more, and we will investigate the letter "S". This is the last Saturday before Christmas: choc-a-block with take-home crafts and Christmas Carols. We celebrate in style with our usual Saturday blend of winter time fun as well as our regular Phonics, Maths & Art activities.

### Monday December 22nd: Reindeer Ready Day!

We kick-off our countdown to Christmas itself today, and the children build up the energy with an exciting expedition to visit the North Pole and meet Rudolph and other Red-Nosed reindeers! Our guests become Arctic explorers and discover the reindeer habitat, their Sami keepers, and unique facts about these incredible animals, also known as caribou. Today will be a fun and investigative mix of fantasy, magic and facts, as we prepare Santa's furry friends with a reindeer training course, and beautify them with gorgeous decorations, to ensure that they are 'Christmas ready'! Children will have great physical fun through a range of sledge/sleigh themed obstacle courses, lots of silly fun and games like 'pin the tail and nose on the reindeer', and some great songs, including of course well loved winter tunes like Rudolph The Red Nosed Reindeer. For a magical tradition, children will also make "Magical Reindeer Food" to sprinkle for Santa's reindeers.

## Tuesday Dec 23rd: 'Elves Workshop' Day

In our last school day before Christmas, the children will become busy elves at work! The whole school will transform into a production line of Christmas toys and cards, and each of our elves will get to take home some surprises to gift to parents/family. They will enjoy some great games and themed activities as they create, sort, wrap and label, and the whole school will be abuzz with Christmas spirit and good cheer! As a special Christmas highlight, we will be joined by a very special elf indeed - larger than life and dressed in costume....some children just might recognise who is underneath that elf hat (our cheeky mascot, Kokomo)! The children will enjoy a range of fun and games, including racing against the clock to dress like an elf, and various challenges across the age groups e.g. 'Build-a-Toy' or items from recycled materials, which they will display in Santa's Toy Shop.

## Saturday December 27th - The Great Christmas Round-Up!

We can't wait to welcome the children back! We are still feeling a bit Christmassy', so today we will be sitting around a toasty campfire, chatting about our Christmas gifts and experiences, and taking time to be thankful by creating little 'thank you' cards. Time around the crackling flames wouldn't be fun without a few healthy snacks, so we will also be enjoying some tasty seasonal toasted chestnuts. We will enjoy some great stories, including 'The Night After Christmas', and UK Boxing Day style cookery, fun memory games and a look at Boxing Day around the world. The children will also help us with a big task - taking the Christmas trees down! After eating all of that Christmas day food, our children need a good workout, and we will enjoy lots of physical themed fun and games on the roof (in good weather), and in our soft gym.

## Monday December 29th: Snowball Fest - Winter Works of Art

Today the children think about special memories they enjoyed in 2025, the seasons and special highlights, and create lovely and varied wintery craft projects e.g. snow globes and 3D dioramas, to celebrate their magical moments. We will be enjoying some snowball fun that lets children of all ages get a little bit messy and very involved, and each group will create a huge, textured 'winter scene' group mural, as well as their themed individual art projects. Across the school we will be making snowball themed tasty treats, like coconut bliss balls, and the roof and gym will be home to challenging snowball games!

## **Tuesday December 30th - New Year Matsuri**

This is our last class of the year and we will be waving goodbye to 2025 in style!

Children will be making festive bunting and glitzy streamers to decorate the rooms, adorning the space with balloons, and adding to the party atmosphere with group large scale 3D firework art that actually lights up! They will make party hats and colourful noise makers, so they can really welcome our own 'pretend' New Year's Eve in with a lot of noise! Of course, no good New Year's party would be complete without food and drink, and they will have a great time making popcorn/snacks and their own delicious fruity punch soda.
